- 7.5 (a) Applicants must give careful thought to their choice of degree programme in relation to the entry requirement for that programme and their own subject passes.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

For admission to programmes of study at **MIDLANDS STATE UNIVERSITY** for any first degree, a student must have the following qualifications in the Cambridge School examination or equivalent:

Other than the required passes in relevant subjects at GCE A Level or equivalent, all applicants must have passed 5 'O' Level subjects or equivalent including English Language and Mathematics at grade C or better for the Faculties of Science and Technology, Commerce, Natural Resources Management and Agriculture and the Department of Geography. Passes in Biology and Mathematics at 'O' level are required in the department of Psychology. For all other programmes applicants should have done 'O' level Mathematics and attained a grade 'E' or better.

DURATION OF STUDY

Duration of study for the Conventional and Parallel programmes includes one year of WORK RELATED LEARNING. The Block Release/Visiting School Programmes are three year degree programmes.

NB* Candidates should note that they will not be considered for first year study programmes at MSU if they have accepted or registered to study at any other University.

ENGLISH LANGUAGE COMPETENCY (For applicants from a non-English speaking background).

Applicants are advised that English is the language of instruction at Midlands State University. Qualifying applicants from non- English speaking background are required to register for a one-semester Intensive English programme prior to starting their degree.
